

PROTOCOL ON QUOTAS TO THE PALESTINIAN AUTHORITY

The Israeli and the Palestinian sides discussed the issue of importation of Quotas of Agriculture products to the Palestinian Authority from the USA, European Union, Turkey, Canada, Mexico, Mercosur countries, and other WTO member states.
